



Stars Competition in the Cafeteria

As discussed at recent Team Meetings, there will be a grade level stars competition in the cafeteria beginning on Monday, November 28th. The purpose of this competition is to reinforce socially appropriate behaviors in the cafeteria by recognizing students who display behaviors consistent with our expectations. The following details are related to the competition. While the competition itself will be explained to students during Science classes prior to the Thanksgiving break, students can benefit from additional reminders, particularly in the class prior to going to lunch.

Stars Competition

- Competition will begin on Monday, November 28th.
- Students can earn a star in the cafeteria by displaying one of the behavioral expectations (**see attached**).
- Stars are actual precut stars with each grade having a different color; **6th = pink, 7th = purple, 8th = gold.**
- Stars are attached to clipboards in the cafeteria.
- Please note that these stars will replace the star slips for the time being in the cafeteria **ONLY**.
- When a star is given to a student, the student will be responsible for writing his/her name on the star and placing it in the appropriate bin.
- Each grade will have its own bin and stars will be tallied and placed on a grade level bulletin board.
- The first grade who reaches **500** stars wins the competition!!!
