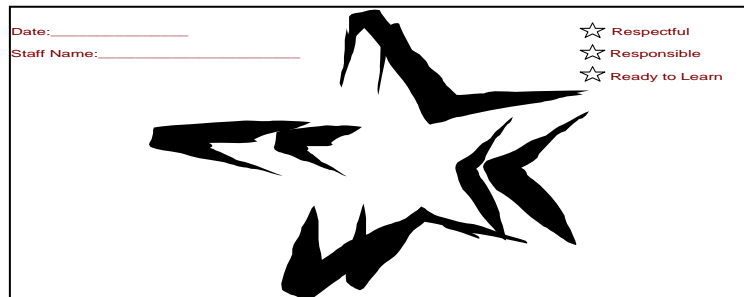


The R's and Stars at Eisenhower Middle School

Be Respectful, Responsible, and Ready to Learn.

- **Everyone** (students and staff) at Eisenhower Middle School is expected to *Be Respectful, Responsible, and Ready to Learn*.
- Every September and periodically throughout the year students and staff participate in activities to learn and review what the Three R's look like.
- What *Be Respectful, Responsible, and Ready to Learn* means and how we should behave will vary across different settings.
- If you need a reminder, just look around for an R's and Stars poster that will tell you exactly what is expected of you in that setting.
- Teachers and staff are always on the lookout for students demonstrating model R's and Stars behavior.
- To let you know if you're a model R's and Stars student, teachers and Staff give out Stars that look like this:



- Teachers and staff will be handing Stars out **many times each day** to students demonstrating R's and Stars expectations. You'll never know when a Star is coming and you won't get one every time you are Respectful, Responsible, or Ready to Learn.
- When get a Star take the top copy with you. The middle copy goes to the main office, and the bottom copy will be **displayed in the cafeteria**.
- When you receive **5 Stars** your family will receive a 5-Star Card in the mail.
- Each week during the morning announcements students who have received 5-Start Cards will have their names read.
- **REMEMBER: We are going to be looking for POSITIVE BEHAVIORS.**

Remember, to receive a Star you need to be Respectful, Responsible, and Ready to Learn throughout your day!
