

Revised Student Recognition System/ Raffle Program

1. Staff members carry tickets and attend to socially appropriate behaviors (respectful, responsible, and safe) in the halls/ stairs, cafeteria, courtyard/ recess and arrival/ dismissal.
2. Student is given a ticket and social feedback by staff member.
3. Student writes his/ her name on the ticket and deposits ticket into classroom container.
4. On Tuesday afternoon, the classroom teacher will draw 5 names from the classroom container. The classroom container will be emptied after drawing these names to begin a new week.
5. These 5 children will receive a certificate and have their names placed in their grade level container in the main office.
6. On Wednesday afternoon, 5/ 6 students per grade (one per classroom) will be drawn from the grade level container.
7. A secretary will read the names of the students during afternoon announcements and the students' names will be posted in the school display case for that week.
8. Students will choose one item from the recognition program menu. If it is an item that involves a teacher or a staff member's time or materials, the time for the use of the item will be at the discretion of the staff member.
9. Cathie Zagari will maintain the raffle containers in the main office and monitor the need for additional raffle tickets.
