


Bobcat Promise

Be Responsible, Respectful, Safe, and Prepared

- **Everyone** (students and staff) at Little Egg Harbor Intermediate School is expected to *Be Respectful, Responsible, Safe, and Prepared*.
- Every September and periodically throughout the year students and staff participate in activities to learn and review what the Bobcat Promise looks like.
- What *Be Respectful, Responsible, Safe, and Prepared* means and how we should behave will vary across different settings.
- If you need a reminder, just look around for a Bobcat poster that will tell you exactly what is expected of you in that setting.
- Teachers and Staff are always on the lookout for students following the Bobcat Promise. When they catch you following one of the Bobcat behaviors, you may receive a Bobcat ticket that looks like this:

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- Tickets come in different colors. A yellow ticket is given out by bus drivers, blue tickets are given out by cafeteria staff, and white tickets are given out by teachers.
- Teachers and staff will be handing Bobcat Ticket **many times each day** to students demonstrating Bobcat behaviors. You'll never know when a ticket is coming and you won't get one every time you are Respectful, Responsible, Safe, and Prepared
- When you get a Bobcat Ticket put it in your grade level's bin located in the cafeteria.
- Every day students' names are drawn from each grade level and read aloud to the school. The students whose names have been drawn are posted on a Wall of Fame in a central location in the building. The students receive a postcard they can bring home to their parents. From the 20 names one is selected to receive a prize.
- On Friday two names from each grade are drawn and those students receive a prize.
- **REMEMBER: We are going to be looking for POSITIVE BEHAVIORS.**

Remember, to receive a Bobcat Ticket you need to be Respectful, Responsible, Safe and Prepared throughout your day!
