

MINOR OFFENSES

Infraction	Definition
<i>Inappropriate Language</i>	Non threatening non directed verbal or gestural messages used within conversation that include swearing, name calling, or use of words in an inappropriate way
<i>Defiance/disrespect</i>	Refusal to follow classroom or school rules, or staff directions, talking back and/or socially rude interactions
<i>Disruption</i>	Intentionally behavior causing an interruption in class or activity. Disruption includes loud talk, noise with materials or body parts, or getting out of seat
<i>Horseplay</i>	Non threatening physical interactions
<i>Missing Detention</i>	Unauthorized missing of detention
<i>Lying/Cheating</i>	Student delivers message that is untrue and or deliberately violates rules
<i>Misuse of Pass</i>	Using a pass for a reason other than it is intended
<i>Tardy</i>	Student is late to class or the start of a school day without a pass
<i>Dress Code Violation</i>	

MAJOR INFRACTIONS

Infraction	Definition
<i>Cutting Class/HR</i>	Unauthorized missing of an assigned period or activity
<i>Abusive/Inappropriate Interactions with Peers and Adults</i>	Threatening verbal or gestural interactions with peers or staff that are directed toward someone including swearing, name calling, or use of words or gestures in an inappropriate way
<i>Fighting/Physical Aggression</i>	Actions involving serious physical contact where injury may occur (e.g., hitting, punching, hitting with objects, kicking, hair pulling, scratching, etc.)
<i>Physical Assault on School Personnel</i>	Intentional aggressive actions (e.g., hitting, kicking, throwing objects at, pushing, etc) directed at school personnel
<i>Inappropriate Sexual Contact</i>	Consensual physical contact between students that is sexual in nature and goes beyond a simple kiss
<i>Harassment</i>	Student delivers disrespectful messages (electronically, verbally, or gesturally) to another person that includes threats, intimidation, obscene gestures, pictures, or written notes. Disrespectful messages include negative comments based on race, ethnicity, disability, religion, gender, age, national origin, and or sexual orientation.
<i>Disruption</i>	Behavior causing an interruption in a class or building activity where the student is not responsive to repeated directions. Disruption includes sustained loud talk, yelling, or screaming; noise with materials or body parts; roughhousing; and or sustained out of seat behavior
<i>Property Misuse</i>	Unauthorized and inappropriate use of school property including technology (e.g., downloading of software, sites, pictures, etc; changing computer settings; or providing personal information to web sites)
<i>Property Damage / Vandalism</i>	Student participates in an activity that results in substantial destruction or disfigurement of property
<i>Forgery/Theft</i>	Student is in possession of, having passed on, or begin responsible for removing someone else's property or has signed a person's name without that person's permission or has used identifying information from another person.
<i>Use/Possession of Tobacco</i>	Student is in possession of or caught using tobacco products
<i>Use/Possession of Drugs, Alcohol</i>	Student is in possession of, caught using, or under the influence of illegal drugs or alcohol
<i>Bomb Threat/ False Alarm</i>	Student delivers message (electronically, verbally, gesturally) or orchestrates the delivery of a message of possible explosive materials being on-campus, near campus, and or pending explosions; student pulls or orchestrates pulling of an unwarranted fire alarm
<i>Possession of a Dangerous Weapon</i>	Student is in possession of knives or guns (real or look alike), or other objects readily capable of causing bodily harm, or creating the impression (as in the case of a fake gun or grenade) of causing bodily harm
